<u>Graph Words: Online Thesaurus</u> - GraphWords is an online interactive English dictionary and thesaurus that helps students find the meanings of words and show connections among associated words. GraphWords creates a map of the word's definitions and synonyms which may be saved as a graphic.

<u>Cambridge Dictionaries Online</u> - Several different Cambridge dictionaries can be searched from this site. Users can search and be given a definition, and then click on any of the other dictionaries to see the definition in each.
