How can identifying and correcting inappropriate shifts in verb form and/or mood help make my writing easier to read and more understandable?</p> <p>Effective communicators utilize their knowledge of standard English grammar and usage to clearly communicate their thoughts and ideas.</p> <p><u>Student Friendly Objectives</u></p> <p><i>Knowledge Targets</i></p> <p>Knowledge Targets</p> <p>Students must explain whether text is written in either active or passive voice.</p> <p>Students must know the indicative mood is used to make a statement or ask a question (e.g., He listens to me.)</p> <p>Students must know the imperative mood is used to give a directive, a strong suggestion, or an order (e.g., Go away! John, come here please.)</p> <p>Students must know a verb in subjunctive mood expresses a condition which is doubtful or not factual; it is most often found in a clause beginning with the word "if"; it is also found in clauses following a verb that expresses doubt, a wish, regret, demand, or proposal (e.g., If I were you, I would run.)</p> <p>Students must identify whether a sentence is written in active or passive voice.</p> <p>Students must identify the mood of a sentence (indicative, imperative, or subjunctive).</p> <p>Students must recognize inappropriate shifts in verb form or tense.</p> <p>Students must recognize inappropriate shifts in verb mood.</p> <p>Students must correct inappropriate shifts in verb form or tense.</p> <p>Students must correct inappropriate shifts in verb mood.</p> <p><u>Vocabulary</u></p>
