

# Kindergarten Class Offerings

RPDP will be offering a Kindergarten Literacy Instruction Professional Growth Module. The module consists of four different classes that can be taken for UNLV graduate credit (one credit each) or as workshops. These engaging classes are hands-on and kindergarten specific! Below is a brief description of each class.

## RPDP 528a CCSS Sharing Text Grade K

This course will focus on the implementation of the Nevada Academic Content Standards in the kindergarten classroom. It will provide an introduction to the Reading Literature (RL) and Reading Informational Texts (RI) standards, and discuss research and resources needed for successful classroom instruction.

## RPDP 528b CCSS Writing Grade K

This course will focus on the implementation of the Nevada Academic Content Standards for Writing in the kindergarten classroom. Participants will increase their understanding of the writing standards as they explore the increased student expectations, discuss effective instructional strategies, and create instructional materials to be used for writing instruction.

## RPDP 528c CCSS Oral Language Development Grade K

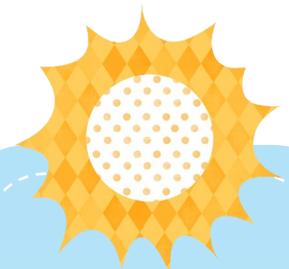
This course will focus on the implementation of the Nevada Academic Content Standards in oral language development, connecting to reading and writing and the Speaking and Listening (SL) Standards. It will provide instruction to the standards as well as the resources and research needed for successful classroom application.

## RPDP 524c Primary Literacy Stations

Current trends, research-based practices, materials, and methods used in primary classrooms to facilitate independent practice of literacy skills while addressing the Nevada Academic Content Standards in literacy. Included will be the management of literacy stations and the integration of phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, comprehension, and vocabulary activities. Teachers will extend their proficiency in three broad categories: knowledge and beliefs about literacy, instruction and assessment, and organization of a primary literacy program.

- **If I only need a few credits to renew my teaching license and am not doing a PGP, can I still take the classes?**

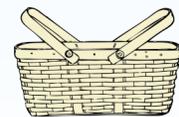
*Yes!*
