Nevada K-12 Endorsement in Reading (NAC 391.285)

To receive an endorsement to teach reading, a person must:

1. Hold a bachelor's degree;
2. Hold a valid elementary, middle school or junior high, secondary or special teaching license, excluding Business and Industry; and
3. Have at least sixteen (16) semester credits in reading to include each of the following areas:
 - a. Foundations of Reading
 - b. Elementary Methods and Materials
 - c. Secondary Methods and Materials
 - d. Diagnosis of Reading Disabilities; and
 - e. A Practicum in Reading Remediation.
