How does the write trace and evaluate argument and specific claims in a text?</p> <p>A writer assess whether reasoning is sound and relevant to trace and evaluate the argument and specific claims in a text.</p> <p><u>Student Friendly Objectives</u></p> <p><i>Knowledge Targets</i></p> <p>I know literary nonfiction is factual information written with literary techniques (e.g., autobiography, prose). I know how to search for relevant information. I can differentiate between informational text and literary non-fiction.</p> <p><i>Reasoning Targets</i></p> <p>I can determine task, purpose, and audience. I can determine text structure or format need to complete a task (e.g., compare/contrast, summarize). I can determine what portions of text are required to complete a task. I can determine if additional information, resources, or text are needed for a task. I can interpret information in a text.
