Letter Identification

The purpose of this assessment is to find out what letters the child knows.

To administer the test, show the child the lower case letters that are provided. Be sure to have the child read across the lines so that the letters are in random order.

Introduce the task by saying "What do you call these?" Record the child's response under comments on the Letter Identification Score Sheet. Place a card under the top row of letters masking the rest of the letters and ask "Can you find some that you know?" Continue with the rest of the letters. If the child does not respond, start with the first letter of his/her name.

On the Letter Identification Score Sheet, check the appropriate column for each response (A for the letter name, S for the sound, or W for word beginning). If the child gives an incorrect response, record their response under IR.

Score only the letters for which the student gives the alphabetic name. Testing for sounds and/or upper case letters is optional.
