Did the author tell someone how to do something or make something?

Do you want to tell the reader how to do something?

Do you want to tell the reader how to make something?

Sequence Pattern Key Words:

first, second, third, etc., then, before, after, finally, following, while, meanwhile, before, next, then, last, finally, another, also during
