Descriptive Pattern Definition:

This pattern gives more information about a topic by attributes, example, or elaboration. An illustration, or example is given by the author based on the assumption about the reader.

When the author assumes and/or the reader has limited experience or knowledge, descriptions and illustrations muddy or confuse the issue.

Descriptive Pattern Paragraph:

This pattern is provided to help or assist the reader to make the connection between the concept, procedure or definition

Descriptive Pattern Question:

Did the author tell the reader what something is?

Do you want to present the properties or critical attributes of something?

Do you want to tell what something is?
