2.NBT.A.2 NUMBER AND OPERATIONS IN BASE TEN

Understand place value.

Count within 1000; skip-count by 5s, 10s, and 100s.

Notes: The emphasis of this standard is simply on the counting sequence. As students develop an understanding of place value, they will extend their ability to count accordingly. It is not necessary to expect students to begin with 1 and count to 1000 in order to evaluate their mastery of this standard.
