## 2. MD.A.1 – Measurement and Data

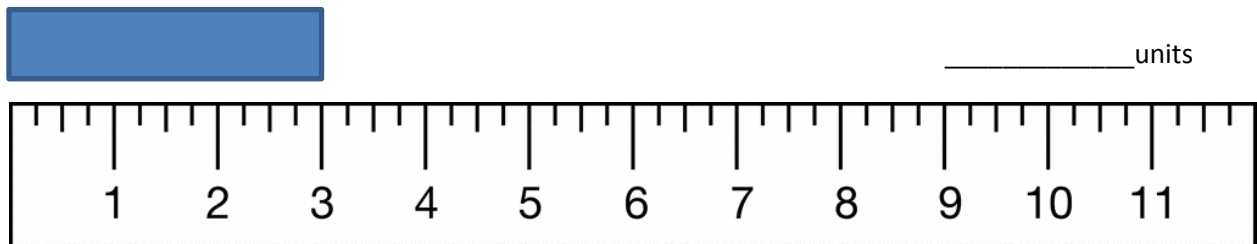
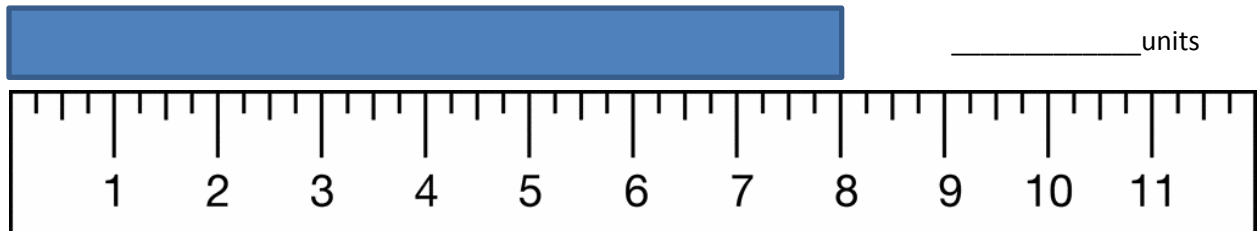
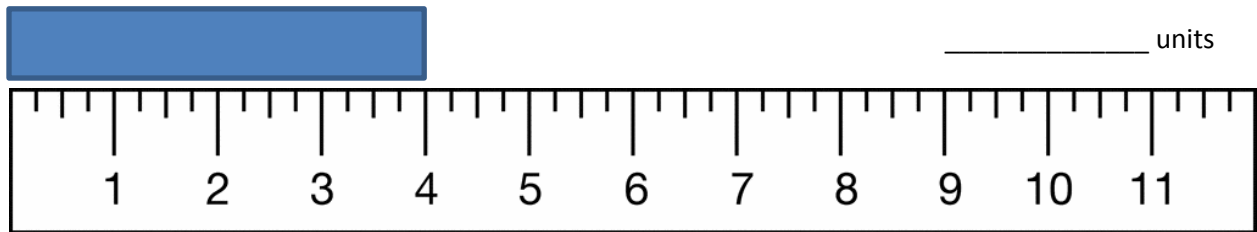
Measure the length of an object by selecting and using appropriate tools such as rulers, yardsticks, meter sticks, and measuring tapes.

Students recognize the need for standard units of measure (centimeter and inch) and they use rulers and other measurement tools with the understanding that linear measure involves a repetition of units. They recognize that the smaller the unit, the more repetitions they need to cover a given length.

Directions: Find the length of each bar.

(Rulers are not an exact measure, but will simulate the use of a standard ruler.)



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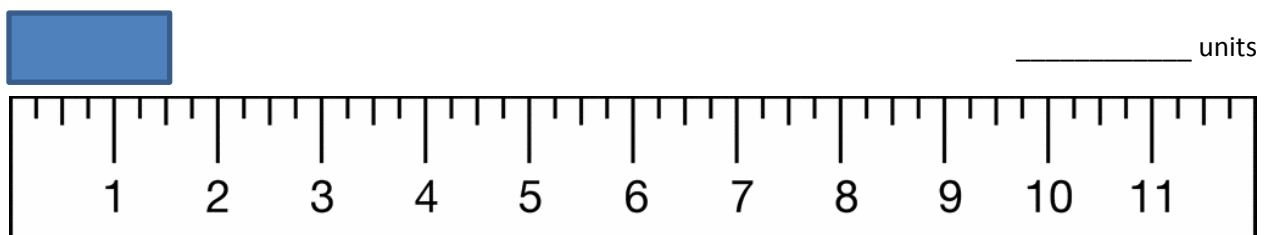
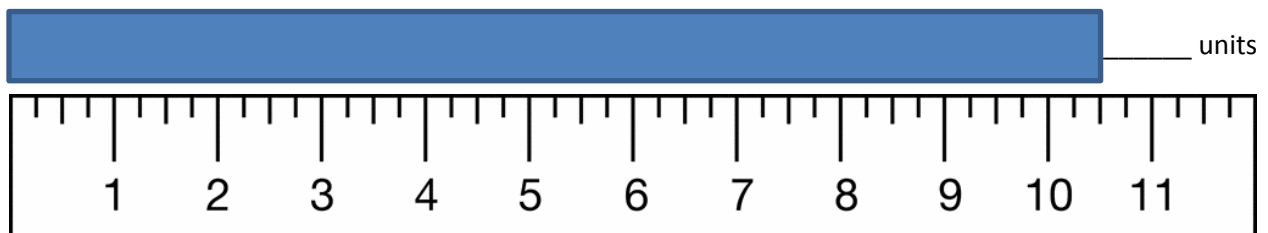
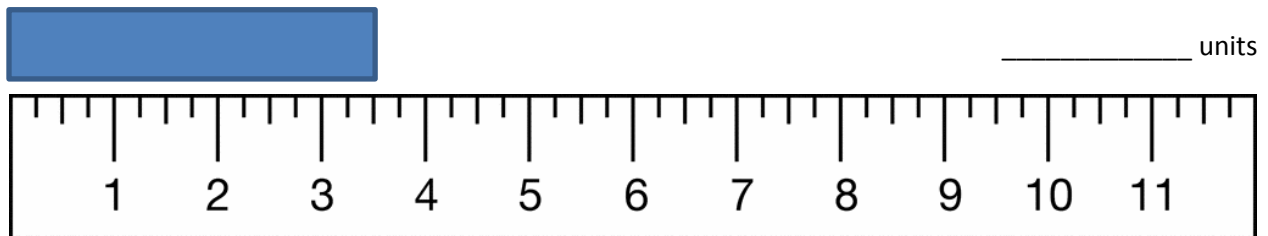
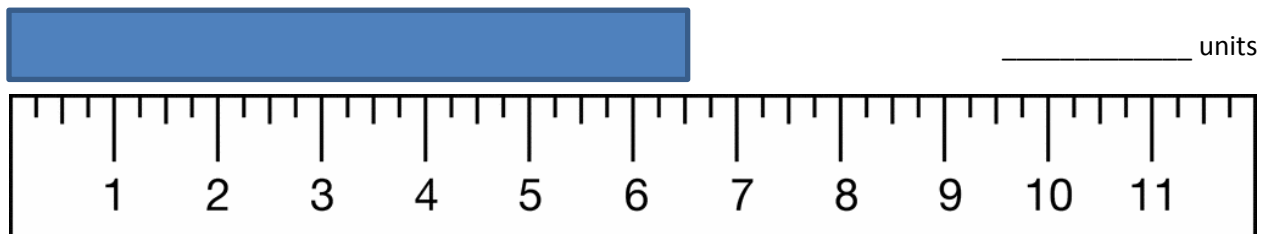


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Directions: Continue to find the length of each bar.



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
