	<p><u>Questions to Focus Learning</u> How does knowledge of vowels impact the ability to read?</p> <p>Knowledge of vowels is an essential component of learning to read.</p> <p><u>Student Friendly Objectives</u> <i>Knowledge Targets</i></p> <p>I know long vowel sounds can be spelled in different ways. I can recognize the final -e spelling pattern. I know two or more letters can make one vowel sound. I can recognize vowel teams. 	<p><u>Teacher Tips</u></p> <p>Activities</p> <p>Fishing for Vowel Digraphs - This activity will have students identifying vowel digraph teams in words. Same but Different - This activity will have students identifying vowel digraph teams in words. Say and Write Letters - This independent student practice allows students to write vowel teams with pictures. Silent "e" Changes - This activity will have students practice how the silent "e" changes words. Vowel Digraph Baseball - This activity will have students identifying vowel digraph teams in words.
