Activities

<u>Sequence-A-Story</u> - This center activity will help students sequence a grade level text.

<u>Sum Summary</u> - This center activity will help students practice summarizing narrative text.

<u>Story Element Sort</u> - This center activity will aide in students' practice identifying story elements from familiar narrative texts.

Story Line Up - This center activity will help students sequence events in familiar narrative texts.

<u>Story Question Cube</u> - This center activity allows students to practice identifying story elements in grade level texts.

Vertical Progression
