	<p><u>Questions to Focus Learning</u> How does awareness of onset and rime support students in the development of phonemic awareness? Onset and rime awareness is a step in the progression toward identifying individual phonemes.</p> <p><u>Student Friendly Objectives</u> <i>Knowledge Targets</i></p> <p>I know syllables have two parts: onset and rime. I know onset is the word part that comes before the vowel. I know rime is the vowel and everything after it.</p> <p><i>Performance Targets</i></p> <p>I know how to blend onset and rime to make a word. I know how to segment a word into onset and rime.</p> <p><u>Vocabulary</u></p> <p>blend onset rime segment syllable(s) vowel</p>
